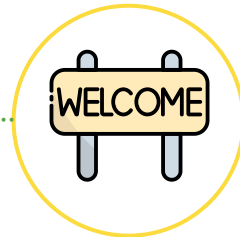
Youth Partnership Council 2023/24

Recruited Youth Partners from across SK



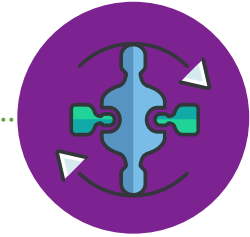
- Recruited 6 new Youth Patient Family Partners from across SK to grow the council for September launch

Visioning Session



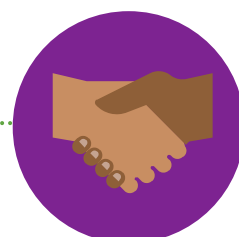
- Brainstormed areas of focus by answering visioning questions:

Youth focus on Our Commitment to Each Other: Patient Rights and Responsibilities



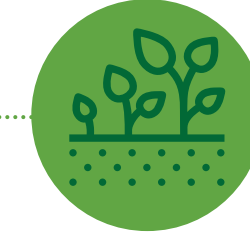
- Reviewed SHA's newly launched Provincial Patient Rights & Responsibilities called Our Commitment to Each Other

Created plan to grow again next year including new Co-Chair role

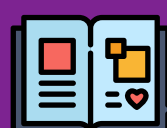


- Reviewed and updated recruitment materials and plan
