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Are you a community health care provider looking to contribute to research that aims to improve the healthy futures of Canadian autistic children and their families?

What is this study about?

Many Canadian children wait too long for autism diagnosis, creating a need to expand capacity among community health care providers (HCPs) to provide this care. Because of their early and ongoing connection to autistic children, community HCPs are pivotal in providing ongoing integrated autism care. The information that we hope to gather from HCPs about their experiences will be used to create toolkits and ECHO Autism content to support HCPs to perform more diagnostic assessments for autism and provide ongoing integrated care for their autistic patients.
