- Adolescents who are willing and able to participate in a semi-structured interview

- Ability to provide assent, with informed consent from a parent or legal guardian
- A parent or caregiver may be present during the interview to provide support if desired

Participation would involve completing an online questionnaire (less than 7 minutes) and one online session (via Zoom) between 30-60 minutes.
